Note
• Use Nakatsu city designated prepaid garbage bags to dispose of "burnable garbage" and "non-burnable garbage."
• Commercial/business garbage may not be disposed of at these collection sites.

Make sure that all garbage and recyclables have been properly separated and are put out at the designated collection sites **by 8:30 am** on collection day. In principle, individual garbage collection service is not available.

Collection may be canceled in the event of adverse weather conditions such as typhoons. If it is canceled, put out garbage on the next scheduled collection day.

Use Nakatsu city designated prepaid garbage bags to dispose of "burnable garbage" and "non-burnable garbage."

Burnable garbage

- Kitchen waste, shells
- Recyclable plastics that are hard to clean and hard to rinse
- Dirty paper, photographs, paper with metal foil, waterproof paper, etc.

Items that can be disposed of in transparent plastic bags by sorting from garbage

- "Paper diapers"
- "Ostomy accessories"
- "Empty bag of peritoneal dialysis fluid"
- "Small branches, grasses, flowers, and fallen leaves"

Why not try "reducing your kitchen waste" by using a composting bin or Nakatsu Kiero?

Non-burnable garbage

- Ceramic/glass
- Lightbulbs
- Sharp items
- Kitchen knives, scissors, and broken ceramic/glass
- Umbrella frames
- Items containing metal
- Metal lids
- Metal items
- Aluminum foil
- Bath powder cans
- Mosquito repellent coil cans
- Do not include hazardous waste.
- Batteries should be removed.

Caution! Iron steel should directly be carried in to Nakatsu City Clean Plaza!

Recyclable plastics

Items that can be put out as "recyclable plastics"

- Plastic containers and packaging
- Plastic contained in products
- Plastic bags, exterior films, etc.
- Snack bags, bread bags
- Wrappings and bags for daily necessities, exterior films, etc.
- Containers for shampoo, conditioner, detergent, etc.
- Containers for cup noodles, yogurt, pudding, etc.
- Trays for meat, vegetables, fish, etc.
- Caps and labels for PET bottles, etc.
- Others: Nets for fruits, Styrofoam cushioning material, etc.
- Various storage containers/bags, etc.
- Tupperware, zipped storage bags
- Vinyl bags, etc.

Items that cannot be put out as "recyclable plastics"

- Items with a side length of 30 cm or more
- Items made from vinyl chloride (PVC, polyvinyl chloride)
- Medical waste
- Items that were used in agriculture and fisheries

Waste papers, used cloths, miscellaneous papers

On rainy days, please put them in transparent plastic bags.

- Newspapers
- Magazines
- Milk cartons
- Miscellaneous papers

How to recognize cardboard: Cross-section has waves like this

Separate newspapers, magazines, and cardboard boxes, and tie each stack lengthwise and widthwise with string.

On rainy days, please place newspapers and magazines into transparent plastic bags to keep them from getting wet.

Please dispose of dirty paper, photographs, paper with metal foil, waterproof paper, etc., as "burnable garbage."

Clothing, curtains, and blankets

School uniforms, work clothes, and clothing items that are worn-out, severely damaged, or dirty should be disposed of them as "burnable garbage."

Glass bottles, cans

Rinse thoroughly! Dispose of the lid separately.

Remove lid

Glass bottles and cans may be disposed of together.

- Cosmetic item bottles
- Beverage cans
- Food cans
- Milk cans
- Snack/confectionery cans
- Tea leaves cans
- Nori (seaweed) cans
- Tempura oil cans
- Oily cans
- Pet food cans

PET bottles

Rinse thoroughly! Remove caps and labels

Flatten

Look for this sign!

Items eligible for collection are limited to PET bottles that originally contained foods/beverages at the time they were sold.

"Caps and labels should be put out as "Recyclable plastics."

"PET bottles with stains should be put out as "burnable garbage."

"Bottles for water dispensers: Check whether they have PET marks first. If they do, they should be flattened before putting out. (Those which have no PET marks or cannot be flattened should be put out as "Recyclable plastics.")"

Hazardous items

Sort items by item type, place them in separate plastic bags, and dispose of them in a manner that they stand out.

Gas canisters, spray cans

Use up the contents (Be sure to dispose of any leftovers outdoors.)

Batteries

Small rechargeable batteries

Fluorescent tubes

Straight tubes

Round tubes

"Bring "swollen small rechargeable batteries" directly to the Nakatsu City Clean Plaza.

"Fluorescent tubes should be put in a case, etc., to prevent breaking, and disposed of in transparent plastic bags. It is OK if they stick out of the bags."

"LED tubes or broken fluorescent tubes should be put out as "non-burnable garbage."

Other categories

Used small household appliances

Small household appliances should be put in collection boxes set up at community centers, etc. Small rechargeable batteries should also be placed in attached boxes.

Batteries and rechargeable batteries should be removed.

Small household appliances will be recycled to recover rare metals.

- Smartphones, telephones, radios, and digital cameras
- Video cameras, HDD recorders, and remote controls
- Desktop calculators, flashlights, and small game consoles
- Accessories (AC adapters and cables)
- Car navigation systems
- Electronic clocks, etc.

Large-sized garbage

Large-sized garbage should not be put out at the garbage pickup place.

Microwave ovens, electric fans, vacuum cleaners, and futon, etc. are large-sized garbage.

Disposal methods

Option 1: Bring it directly to Nakatsu City Clean Plaza.

Option 2: Apply by phone, contacting Nakatsu City certified municipal waste collection and transportation contractor.

Option 3: Apply by phone to Nakatsu City Clean Plaza or one of the Nakatsu City branch offices, or apply online. Please note that there are various conditions for the city's collection services.

Items not collected at garbage collection sites

- Business and corporate garbage
- Large-sized garbage
- Garbage from moving, and temporary large amounts of garbage
- Products subject to the Home Appliance Recycling Law
- PC
- Items difficult to dispose of

Contact the dealer from where you purchased the item or qualified disposal company for proper disposal.
